

Morgys Custom Tack Chap Measurement Chart

When measuring for your chaps, make sure you stand square and even. It is best that you get someone else to measure you so you are not bending and twisting. A soft measuring tape is ideal and can usually be picked up from a supermarket or fabric store. Please keep measurements as close to correct as possible. If you add to them then the chaps will in turn fit bigger. Measurements in either inches or cm are fine. Any questions please don't hesitate to ask, 0423228232.

Measure just below your belt

2) Upper Thigh. _____

3) Mid Thigh. _____

Half way between Upper thigh
And Knee.

4) Knee. _____

Morgys will add 2 inches to this for flex.

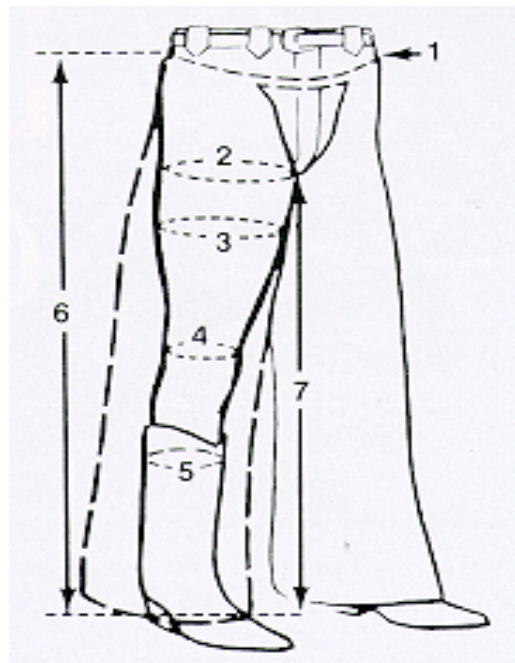
5) Calf. _____

Measure the widest part.

6) Outseam. _____

Morgys will add 3 inches to this.

7) Inseam. _____
